

Example: Zambia Safari with Victoria Falls



6 days with safari in Zambia ending with a few days in Victoria Falls. The trip starts in Lusaka where you board a small aircraft bound for South Luangwa with some of the best game viewing that Africa can offer. After your safari you go by vehicle and small aircraft to Victoria Falls for two overnights at the Zimbabwean side of the falls. The example is priced for 4 persons for 2017, African winter/Northern hemisphere late summer/fall.

Day 1, From Lusaka to Luangwa: You arrive at Lusaka Airport and are met and helped to the domestic flight to Mfuwe. Upon arrival Mfuwe airport you are met by a representative for the lodge and taken to the camp.

Overnight 3 nights in safari tents/huts. All meals and local drinks (no premium brands) included, as well as game activities, park fees and conservation fees. There might be time for a game drive that afternoon, followed by dinner.



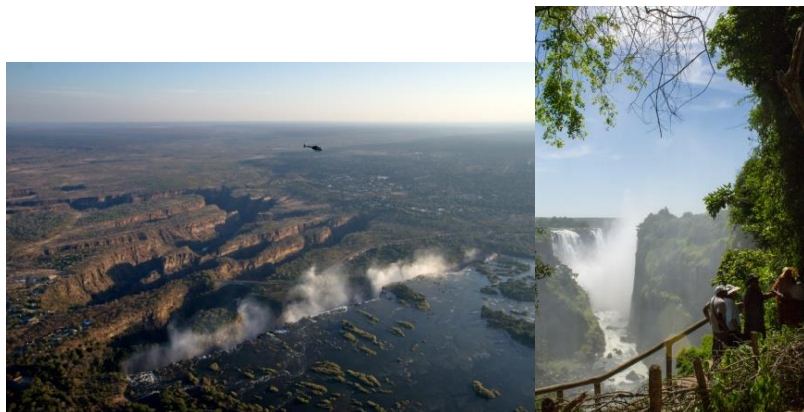
Day 2 and 3: Safari in South Luangwa National Park. You spend the days game watching on foot or from a 4x4 safari vehicle, you can choose yourself whether you want to walk or be in a vehicle. You will return to camp midday for lunch and a bit of rest, after that you go out again searching for new adventures and thrilling encounters. You will return to camp for dinner and overnight.





Day 4, To Victoria Falls: You will be taken by road back to Mfuwe airport where you board a flight for Livingstone. There is a short stop over in Lusaka. Upon arriving Livingstone airport by Victoria Falls you will find your driver and taken to the Zimbabwe side of the falls. Overnight 2 nights, breakfasts included, at hotel close to the falls.

Victoria Falls is mostly about the falls which can be viewed on foot and is most spectacular from the Zimbabwean side. You can walk down to the park surrounding the falls, there is a fee to get in. You might consider bringing a raincoat for the spray, or buy a local one. To view the falls from the Zambian side you can walk across the border-bridge, bring your passport.



Day 5, Victoria Falls: The day is at your own disposal until the afternoon, to meander and enjoy the magnificent waterfall. Or you can try various more or less daring activities that are on offer in the vicinity of the falls: bungi jumps, flying slides/ zip lines in variations, kanoing, white water rafting, horse back riding, to mention some.



In the afternoon you will be collected and taken to your boat cruise on the mighty Zambezi River. Drinks and snacks are served on board. The tour ends at sunset time, and back on the dock your driver will be there to take you back to the hotel. This excursion is included.



Day 6, departure: After breakfast you will be taken to the airport for your onward flight.

Prices 2017, African winter/Northern hemisphere late summer/fall

This is a price estimate based on 4 persons sharing. Standard rooms/tents, 3 to 4 star hotels/safari lodges

Estimated price: about USD 4.200 per person sharing.

Included:

3 nights on safari with breakfast, lunches and dinners. Local drinks excluding premium bands, game viewing activities, park fees, conservation fees, services from camp staff and rangers.

2 nights at hotel in Victoria Falls Zimbabwean side, breakfasts included.

Sunset Cruise on the Zambezi River with drinks, snacks and return transfers.

Meet and greet at Lusaka airport.

Road transport as mentioned in the program

Flights, small aircrafts:

Lusaka – Mfuwe one way, taxes included.

Mfuwe – Lusaka – Livingstone one way, taxes included.

Please note: Flight prices change every day and might be higher than in this estimate. The prices are only valid for 24 hours at a time.

Please also note there is a luggage limit of 15 kg on small aircraft, packed in soft bags. A reasonable amount of camera equipment is allowed as hand luggage.

Not included: International flights, visa expenses, drinks and meals not mentioned as included, activities/excursions/sightseeing not mentioned as included, personal insurance, gratuities and other expenses of a personal nature.
